Sheila Penrose is a director of McDonald's Corp and JLL Inc., where she serves as Chairman of the Board. Sheila was the first woman on Northern Trust Corporation's Management Committee, as President of Corporate and Institutional Services. She represented Northern Trust with the investor community, oversaw several acquisitions, and drove the bank's global expansion. In the UK, Sheila was Economic Advisor at the British Treasury and Economics Lecturer at Central London Polytechnic.

Sheila is a Trustee of the Chicago Council on Global Affairs, Rush University Medical Center, and Museum of Science and Industry, among other organizations. She received an economics degree and graduate diploma in education from University of Birmingham, England; a master's degree from the London School of Economics; and attended the Executive Program at Stanford Graduate School of Business, where she later served on the Advisory Board. Sheila is a founding member of the 30% Club in the US, which advances women on corporate boards; an advisor on Gender Parity at the World Economic Forum (Davos); and served on the Advisory Board of Catalyst, the leading research organization on women in corporate roles.
